Math at Home Family Letter for Unit 5

Dear Family,

During the next few weeks, our math class will be learning about division of whole numbers.

You can expect to see work that provides practice in dividing numbers 2 through 10. We will also learn about the special rules that apply to 0 and 1.

As we learn about fact families and the relationship between multiplication and division, you may wish to use this sample as a guide.

Vocabulary

dividend The number that is divided in division.

divisor The number by which a number is being divided.

fact family Related facts that use the same numbers but different operations.

$$3 \times 5 = 15$$
 $5 \times 3 = 15$

$$15 \div 5 = 3$$
 $15 \div 3 = 5$

quotient The answer to a division problem.

Writing Fact Families for Multiplication and Division

Since multiplication and division are related operations, we can write groups of number sentences called fact families.

The number sentences in a fact family are mathematically related to each other.
