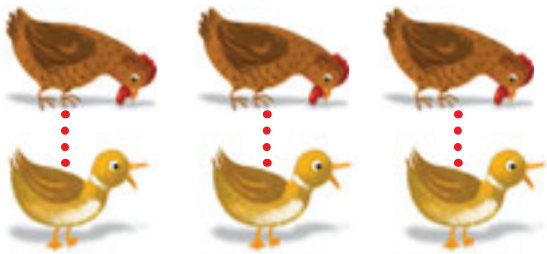

**match one-to-one** A way to compare the number of objects in two groups



**more, less, fewer** Words used to compare numbers of objects in a group or set



There are more cows than sheep.  
There are fewer sheep than cows.  
The set with the cows has more.  
The set with the sheep has less.
