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## Vocabulary

**addition sentence** A way to record when you add

$$\begin{array}{ccccccccc} 3 & + & 2 & = & 5 & & & & \\ & \uparrow & & \uparrow & \uparrow & & & & \\ & \text{plus} & & \text{equals} & \text{sum} & & & & \\ & \text{sign} & & \text{sign} & & & & & \end{array}$$

**subtraction sentence** A way to record when you subtract

$$\begin{array}{ccccccccc} 7 & - & 1 & = & 6 & & & & \\ & \uparrow & & \uparrow & \uparrow & & & & \\ & \text{minus} & & \text{equals} & \text{difference} & & & & \\ & \text{sign} & & \text{sign} & & & & & \end{array}$$
