

Dear Family,

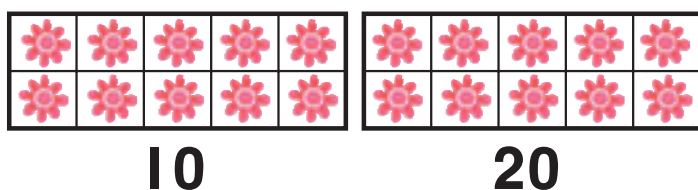

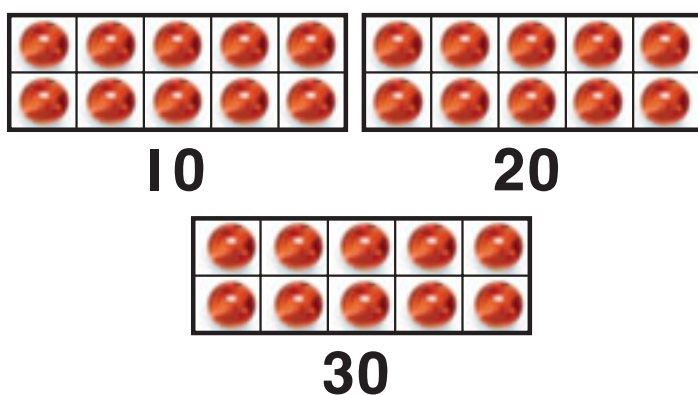
