Write a number sentence to find the difference.

1. Alita counts **4** pigs in a pen.
Then **1** pig gets out.
How many pigs are left in the pen?

$$4 - 1 = \underline{\quad\quad} \text{ pigs}$$

3. Dave sees **9** birds in the tree. Then **3** birds fly away.
How many birds are left in the tree?
