**Subtract. Check by adding.**

1. 6 frogs are in a pond.  
1 frog hops away.  
How many frogs are left in the pond?

2. 7 bees are in a hive.  
3 bees fly away.  
How many bees are left in the hive?

3. Rosita has 9 apples.  
She gives 3 apples to Mary.  
How many apples does Rosita have left?

4. Cassie has 8 softballs. She throws 5 softballs over the fence. How many softballs does Cassie have left?

5. Zach has 6 green books and 10 blue books.  
He takes 3 blue books to the library. How many blue books does Zach have left?

6. Enrique has 11 grapes and 12 cherries.
