3. Barbara has **12** stamps. She uses **2** stamps to mail letters. How many stamps does she have left?

5. Marcos has **12** oranges and **10** apples. He eats **3** oranges. How many oranges does he have left?

2. There are **9** bees in the hive. Then **4** bees fly away. How many bees are in the hive now?

$$9 - 4 = \underline{\quad} \text{ bees}$$

4. Ray has **11** toy cars. He gives **3** toy cars to Keith. How many toy cars does Ray have left?

\_\_\_\_\_ toy cars

6. Kiera has **11** red hair bows and **12** blue hair bows. She loses **5** blue hair bows. How many blue hair bows does Kiera have now?

\_\_\_\_\_ blue hair bows
