Solve.

1. There are **17** children in the room. **8** of the children are boys. How many of the children are girls?

$$17 - 8 = \underline{\quad} \text{ girls}$$

Hint: Remember that
 $8 + 9 = 17$

3. There are **20** crackers in the bag. Enrique eats **10** of the crackers with lunch. How many crackers are left in the bag?

 crackers

5. There are **18** frogs and **17** ants on a log. A loud noise makes **7** frogs jump off the log. How many frogs are on the log now?

 frogs

2. Lance sees **18** birds at the beach. Then **9** birds fly away. How many birds are on the beach now?

$$18 - 9 = \underline{\quad} \text{ birds}$$

Hint: Remember that
 $9 + 9 = 18$

4. There are **17** clay bowls on the shelf. Tamika sells **9** of the bowls. How many bowls are left on the shelf?

 bowls

6. Ciara has **19** blue ribbons and **16** red ribbons. She ties **9** red ribbons to balloons. How many red ribbons does Ciara have now?

 red ribbons
