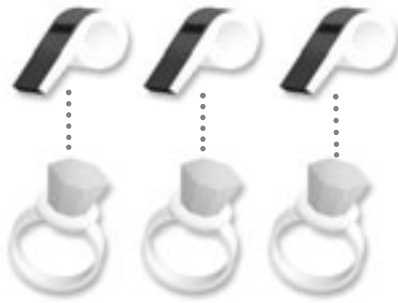

Vocabulary

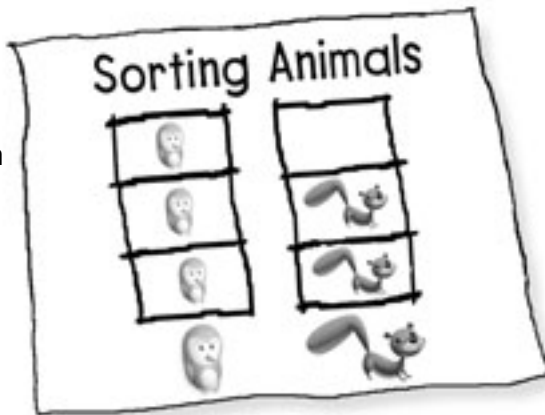
match one to one
