## Vocabulary

These are some words I will use in this unit.

**cent sign** The sign used to show cents (¢)

**minute** A unit of time equal to 60 seconds

**dollar sign** The symbol used to show dollars (\$)

**hour** A unit of time equal to 60 minutes

**decimal point** The dot used to separate dollars and cents

**half-hour** A unit of time equal to 30 minutes

**second** A unit of time; there are 60 seconds in one minute.

**quarter-hour** A unit of time equal to 15 minutes

Some other words I will use are **calendar**, **dime**, **equal amount**, **nickel**, **penny**, **quarter**, **half-dollar**, and **dollar**.

# How To tell time to five minutes

In this unit, I will be learning how to tell time to the hour, half-hour, quarter-hour, and five minutes. This is an example of how I will be learning to tell time to five minutes.

Sometimes, you can skip count by 5s to tell time.



15 minutes after 1

hour → 1 : 15 ← minutes after the hour



40 minutes after 3

3 : 40
