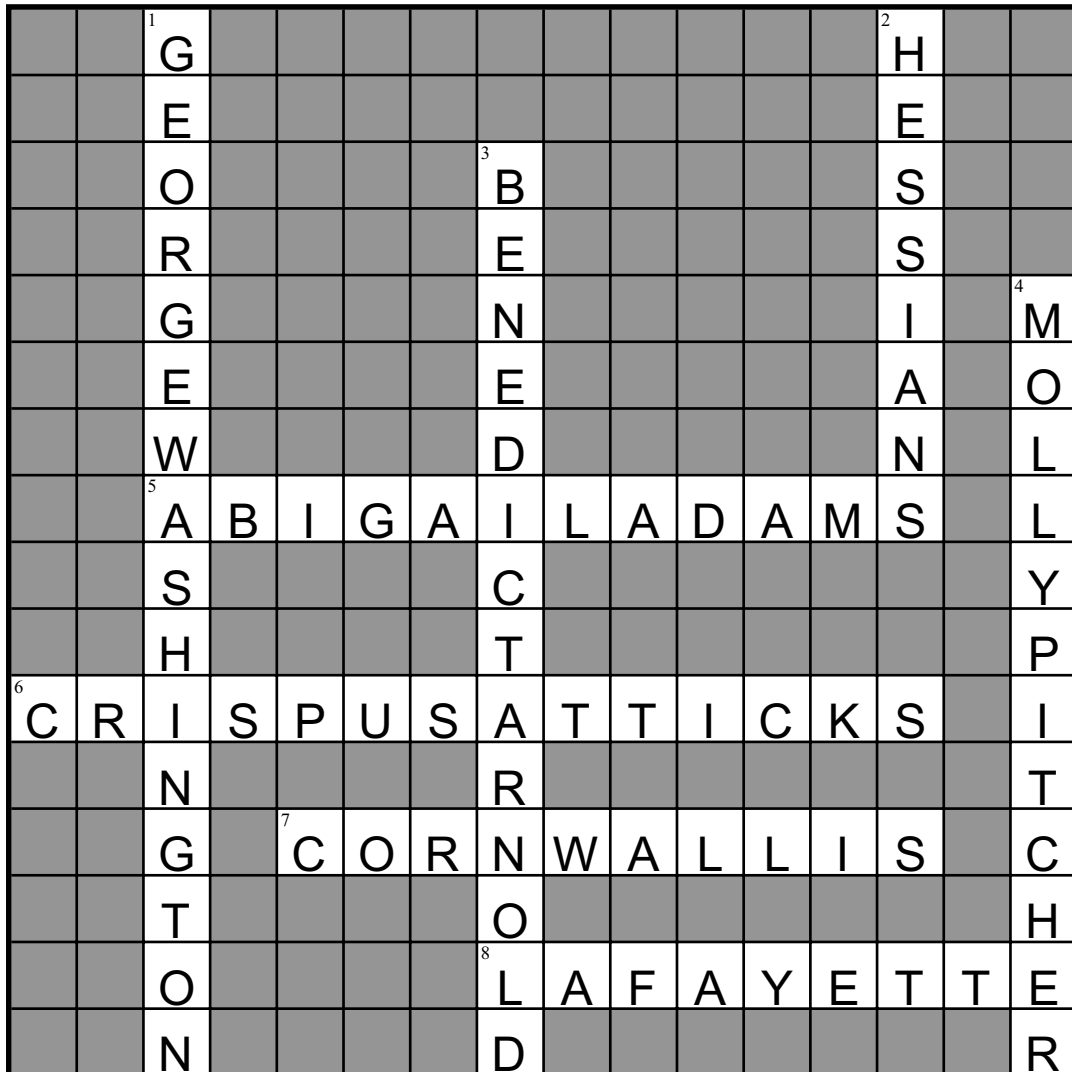


## Revolutionary People Answer Key

- While the Declaration of Independence was being written, she encouraged her husband to remember women's rights.
- Killed in the Boston Massacre in 1770, he is sometimes considered the first American killed in the Revolution.
- His surrender won Americans their independence.
- He ran away to fight with the Americans before his country was officially supporting the rebellion.

### Down

- He took command of the Continental Army on July 3, 1775, in Cambridge, Massachusetts.
- These German soldiers fought for the British.
- He helped win a battle for the Americans at Saratoga before switching sides.
- Legend says that she helped fire her husband's cannon when he was wounded at the Battle of Monmouth.
